Market value of agricultural products sold

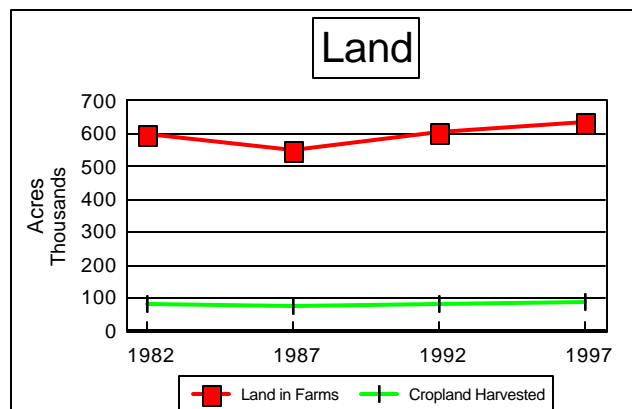
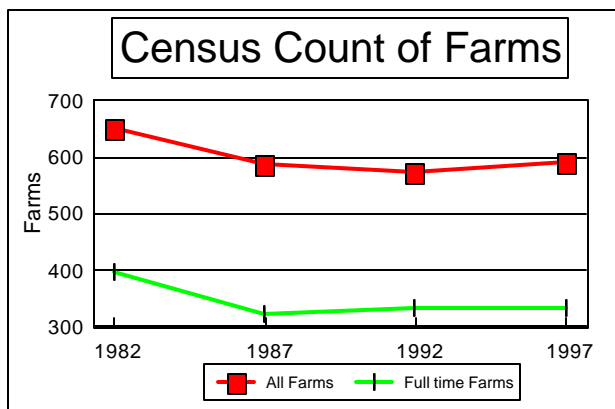
Increased 16 percent to \$57,960,000 in 1997.
