Decreased 4 percent from 456 farms in 1992 to 440 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

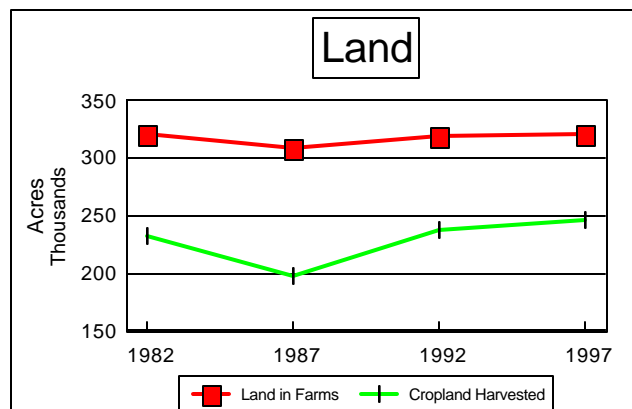
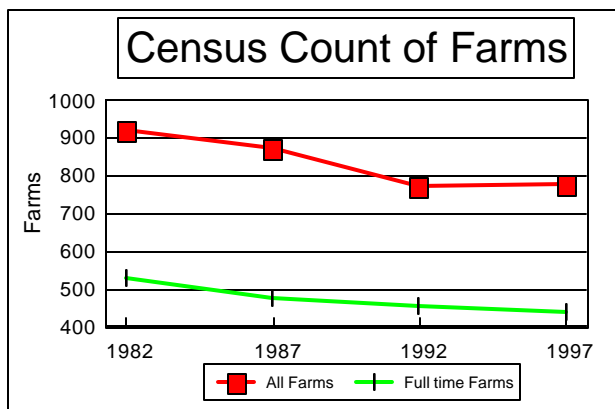
Increased 24 percent to \$71,397,000 in 1997.
