Increased 20 percent from 1,278 acres in 1992 to 1,530 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 21 percent from 239 farms in 1992 to 190 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

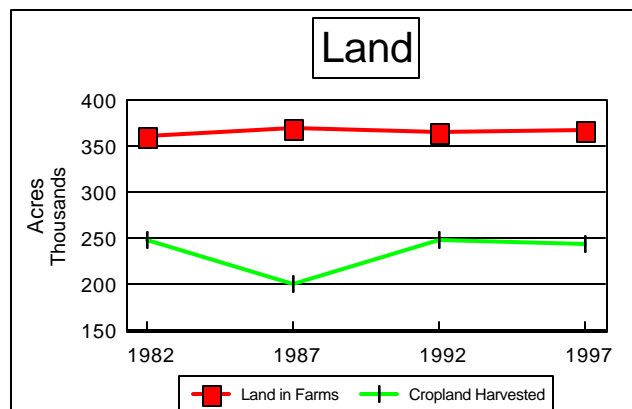
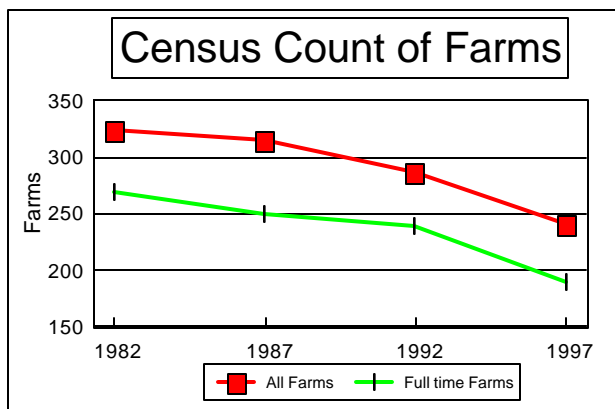
Increased 19 percent to \$432,446,000 in 1997.
