## JEWELL KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 5 percent from 484,823 acres in 1992 to 459,122 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 8 percent from 736 acres in 1992 to 793 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 15 percent from 500 farms in 1992 to 424 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

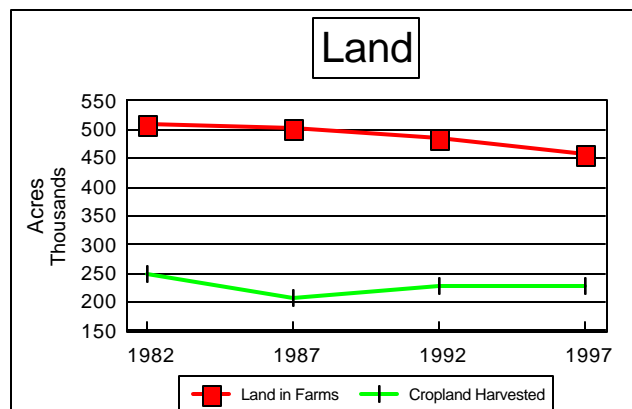
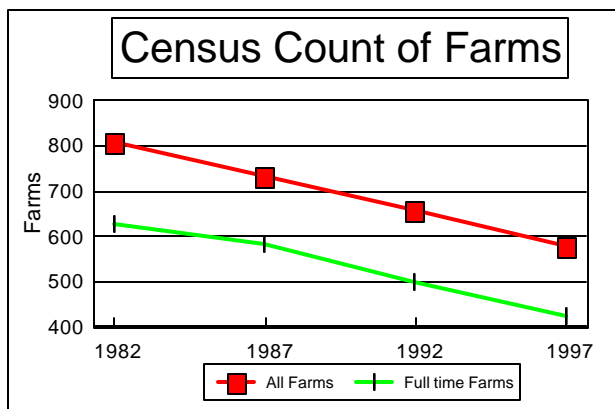
Increased 2 percent to \$51,224,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 63 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 37 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 16 percent from \$76,260 in 1992 to \$88,470 in 1997.
