Decreased 15 percent from 267 farms in 1992 to 228 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

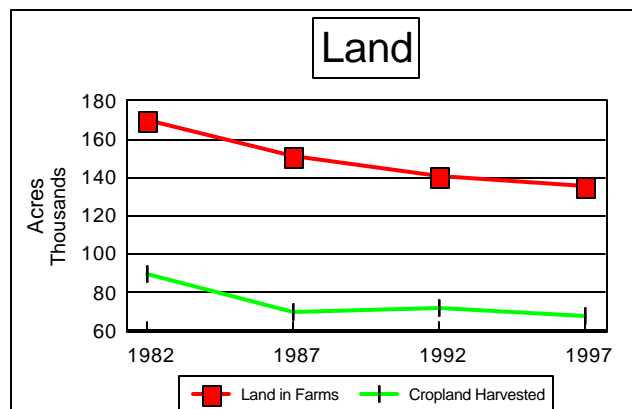
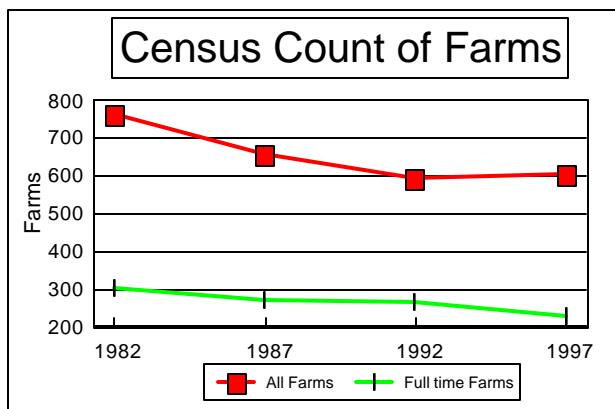
Increased 32 percent to \$37,332,000 in 1997.
