## KINGMAN KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 4 percent from 544,071 acres in 1992 to 520,667 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 3 percent from 704 acres in 1992 to 686 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 11 percent from 494 farms in 1992 to 441 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

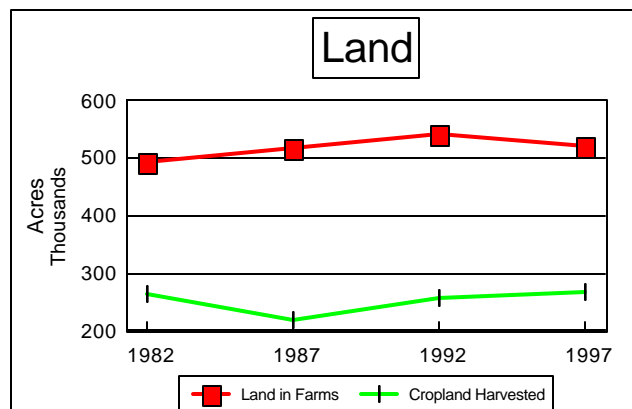
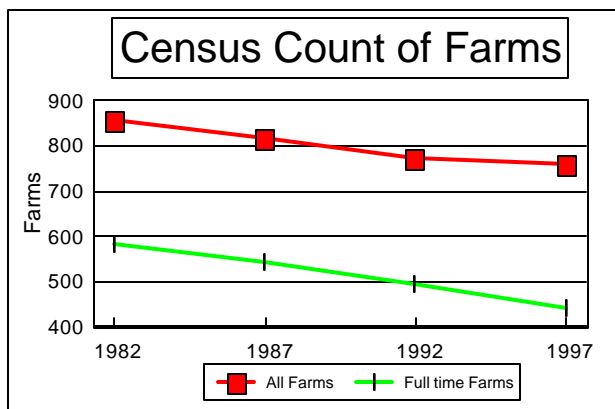
Increased 16 percent to \$56,075,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 61 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 39 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 18 percent from \$62,735 in 1992 to \$73,880 in 1997.
