## LEAVENWORTH KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 2 percent from 206,530 acres in 1992 to 201,826 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 3 percent from 198 acres in 1992 to 193 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 2 percent from 440 farms in 1992 to 430 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

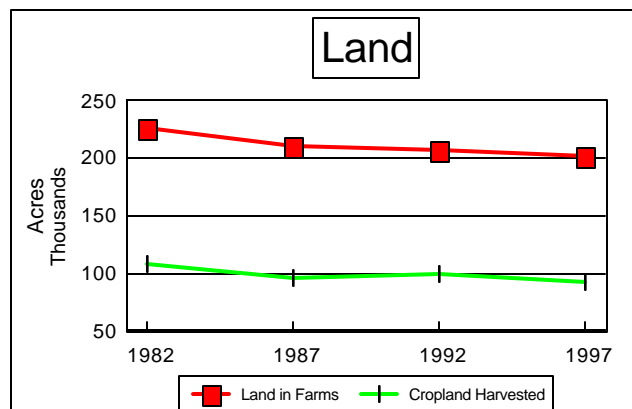
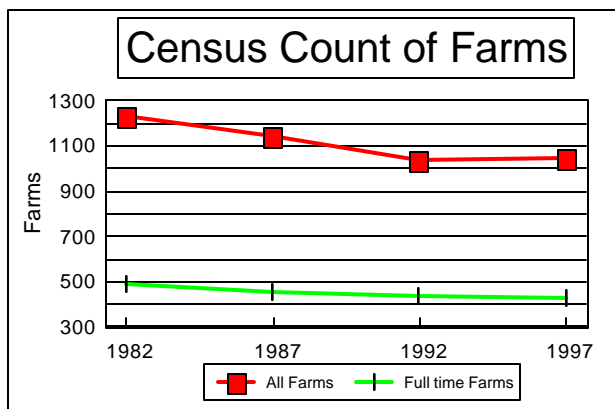
Increased 33 percent to \$42,483,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 66 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 34 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 33 percent from \$30,636 in 1992 to \$40,615 in 1997.
