Decreased 11 percent from 254 farms in 1992 to 226 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

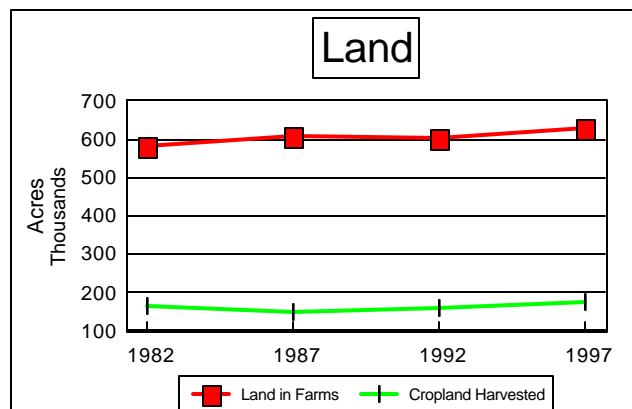
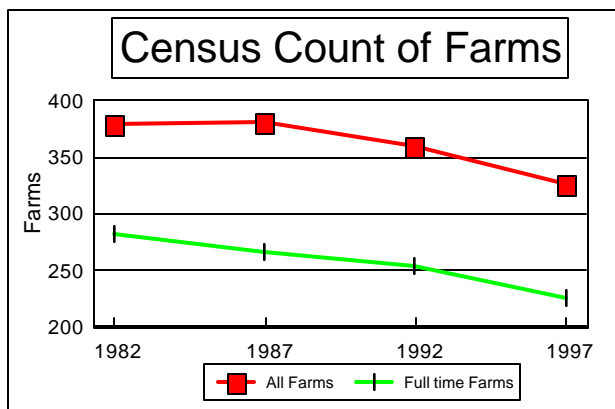
Increased 32 percent to \$36,271,000 in 1997.
