Average size of farms

Decreased 3 percent from 581 acres in 1992 to 563 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 410 farms in 1992 to 381 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

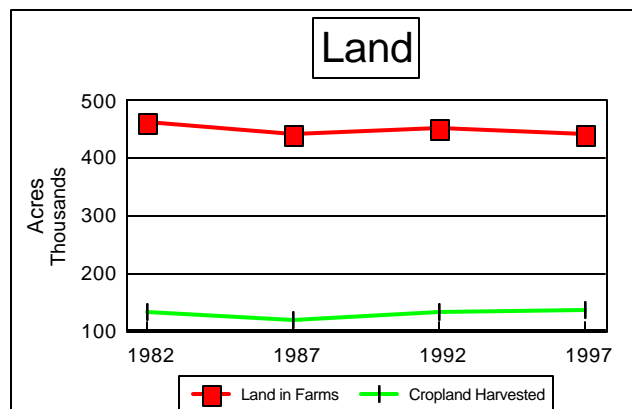
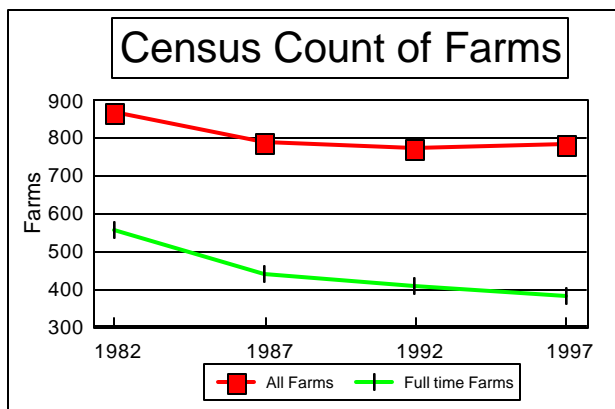
Increased 1 percent to \$51,811,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 33 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 67 percent of the market value.
