Market value of agricultural products sold

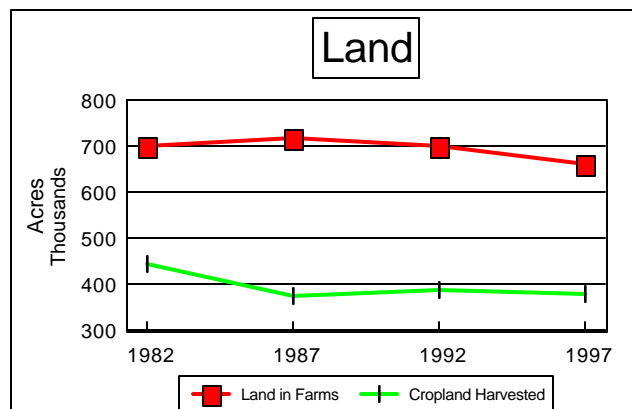
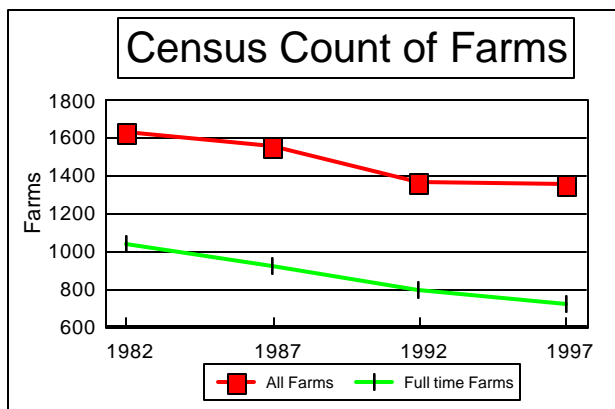
Increased 22 percent to \$133,987,000 in 1997.
