## SHAWNEE KANSAS

### Land in farms

Decreased 1 percent from 227,349 acres in 1992 to 224,143 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 1 percent from 276 acres in 1992 to 272 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 6 percent from 357 farms in 1992 to 336 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

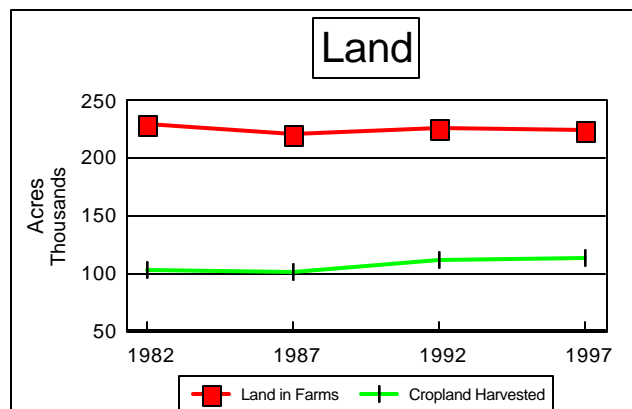
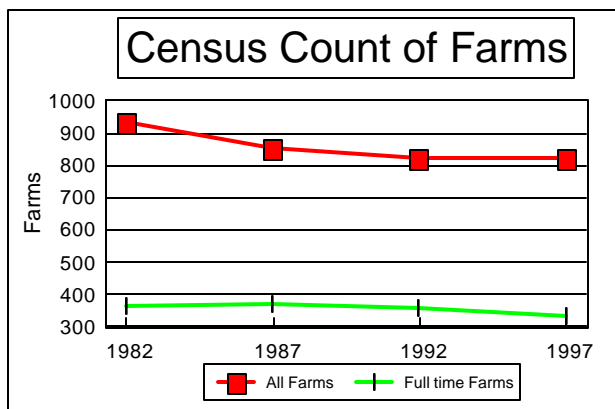
Decreased 2 percent to \$29,103,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 74 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 26 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm
