Increased 7 percent from 151 acres in 1992 to 162 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 16 percent from 40,175 farms in 1992 to 33,841 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 15 percent to \$3,064,460,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 52 percent of the market value.
