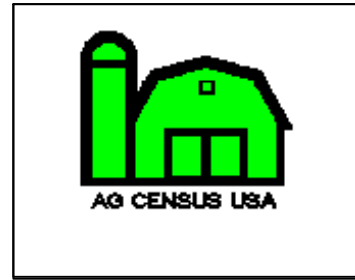

TODD KENTUCKY

Land in farms

Increased 15 percent from 165,015 acres in 1992 to 189,968 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 11 percent from 253 acres in 1992 to 280 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 2 percent from 345 farms in 1992 to 339 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

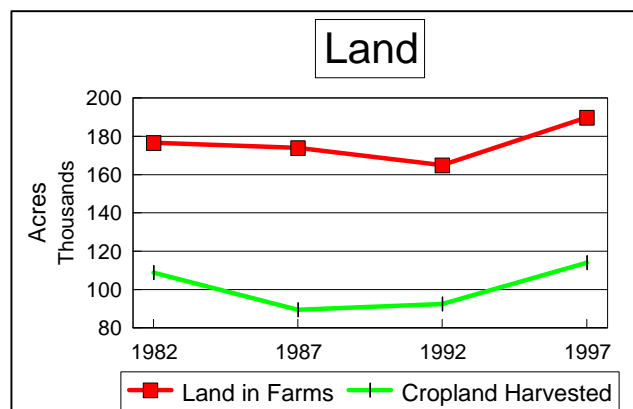
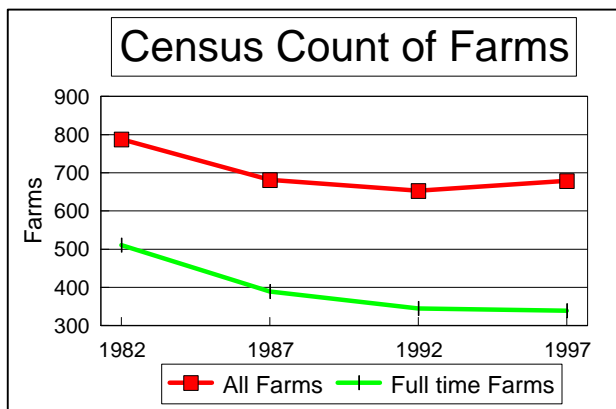
Increased 47 percent to \$69,686,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 59 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 41 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 41 percent from \$72,785 in 1992 to \$102,631 in 1997.
