## WARREN KENTUCKY

### Land in farms

Increased slightly from 252,817 acres in 1992 to 254,813 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 9 percent from 129 acres in 1992 to 140 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 14 percent from 805 farms in 1992 to 696 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

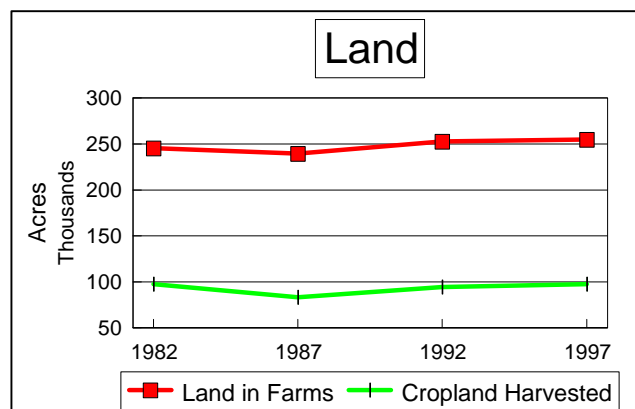
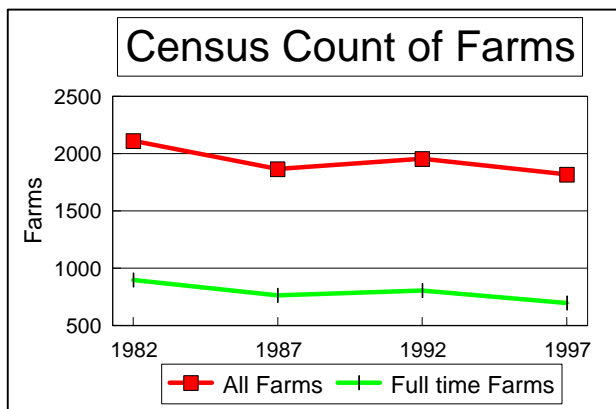
Increased 20 percent to \$65,241,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 38 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 62 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 29 percent from \$27,865 in 1992 to \$35,867 in 1997.
