

Increased 21 percent from 355 acres in 1992 to 428 acres in 1997.

Decreased 19 percent from 452 farms in 1992 to 367 farms in 1997.


Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 48 percent to \$66,593,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 96 percent of the market value. Livestock sales accounted for 4 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 74 percent from \$59,824 in 1992 to \$104,377 in 1997.
