

Increased 32 percent from 126,839 acres in 1992 to 166,915 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 21 percent from 257 acres in 1992 to 310 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 12 percent from 324 farms in 1992 to 286 farms in 1997.


Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 45 percent to \$43,339,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 94 percent of the market value. Livestock sales accounted for 6 percent of the market value.

Increased 33 percent from \$60,493 in 1992 to \$80,407 in 1997.
