Decreased 21 percent from 155 acres in 1992 to 122 acres in 1997.

Decreased 4 percent from 67 farms in 1992 to 64 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

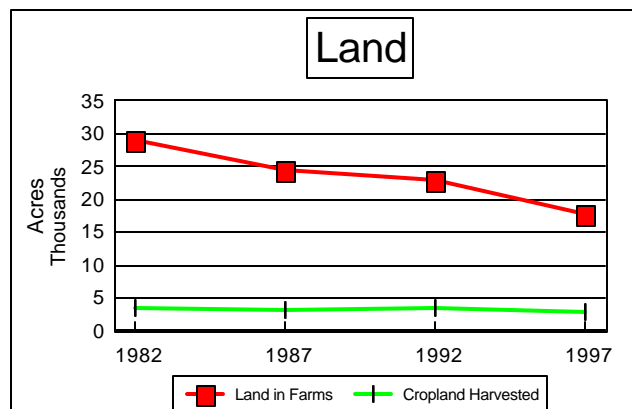
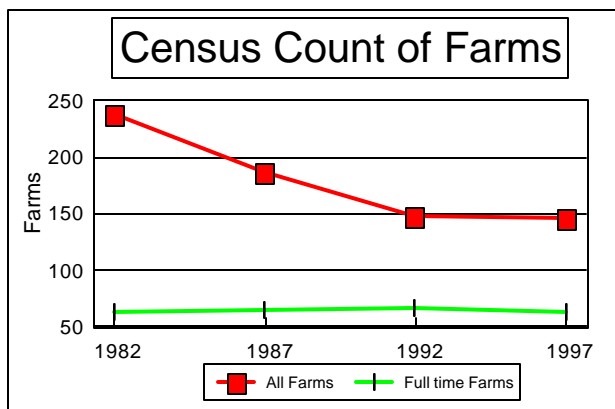
Increased 5 percent to \$3,076,000 in 1997.
