Market value of agricultural products sold

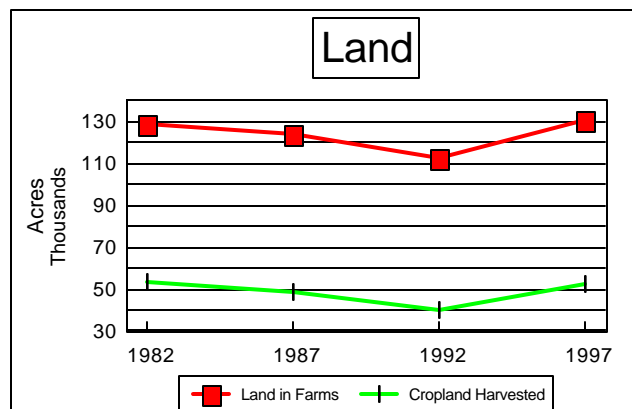
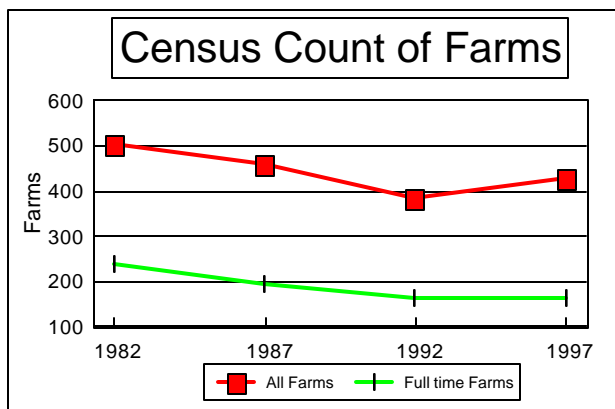
Increased 52 percent to \$23,359,000 in 1997.
