## JACKSON MINNESOTA

### Land in farms

Decreased 4 percent from 401,039 acres in 1992 to 383,631 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 2 percent from 390 acres in 1992 to 398 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 15 percent from 809 farms in 1992 to 684 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

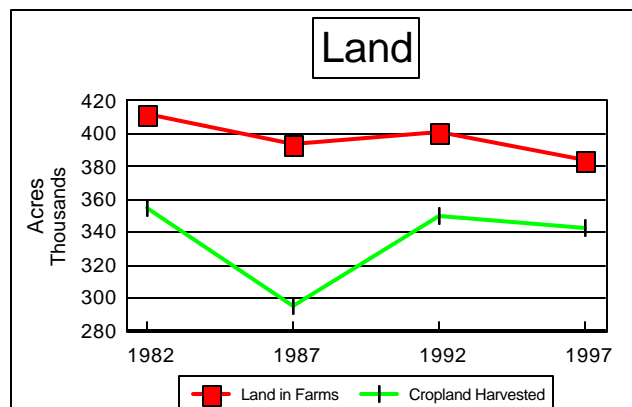
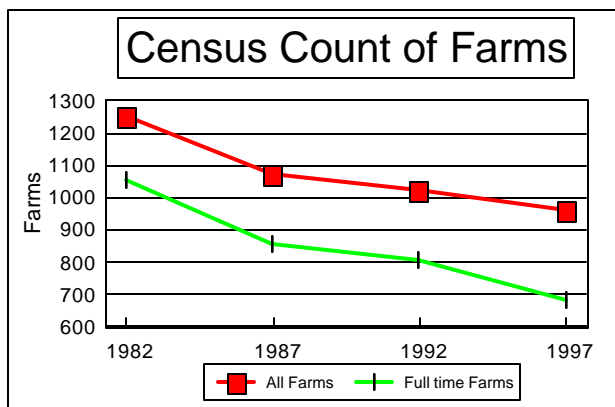
Increased 18 percent to \$150,391,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 59 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 41 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 26 percent from \$123,624 in 1992 to \$156,169 in 1997.
