## WINONA MINNESOTA

### Land in farms

Decreased slightly from 290,627 acres in 1992 to 289,708 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 4 percent from 267 acres in 1992 to 277 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 14 percent from 809 farms in 1992 to 692 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

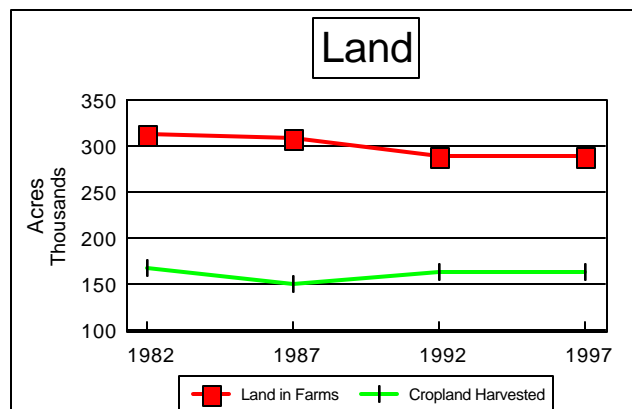
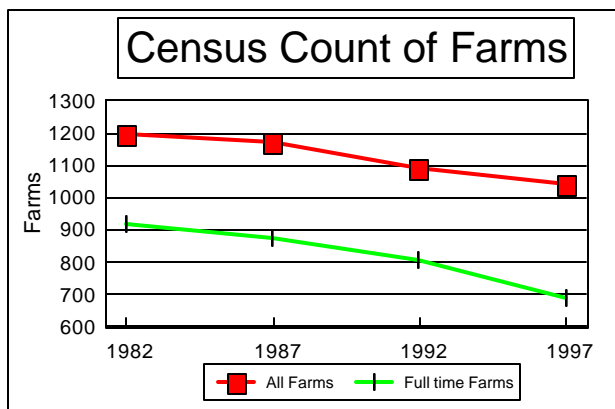
Increased 32 percent to \$122,064,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 21 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 79 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 38 percent from \$84,866 in 1992 to \$116,920 in 1997.
