Decreased 11 percent from 110 farms in 1992 to 98 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

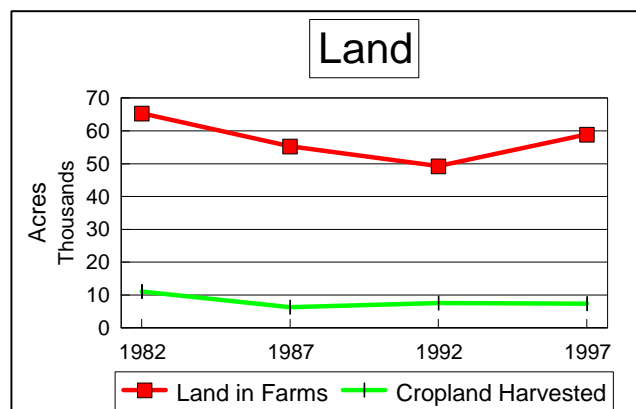
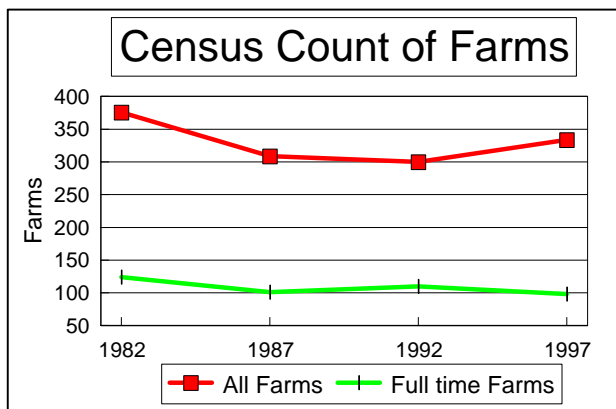
Increased 17 percent to \$11,830,000 in 1997.
