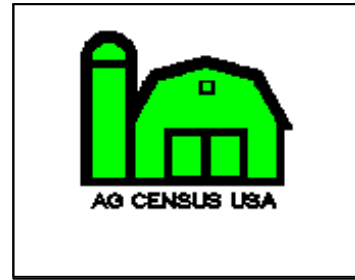

TISHOMINGO MISSISSIPPI

Land in farms

Increased 10 percent from 40,676 acres in 1992 to 44,866 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 15 percent from 151 acres in 1992 to 174 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 18 percent from 83 farms in 1992 to 68 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

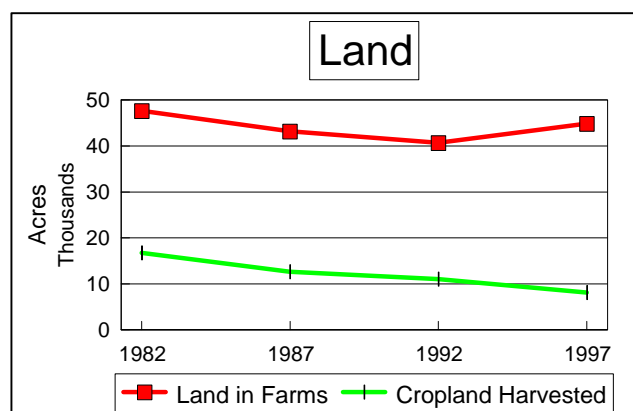
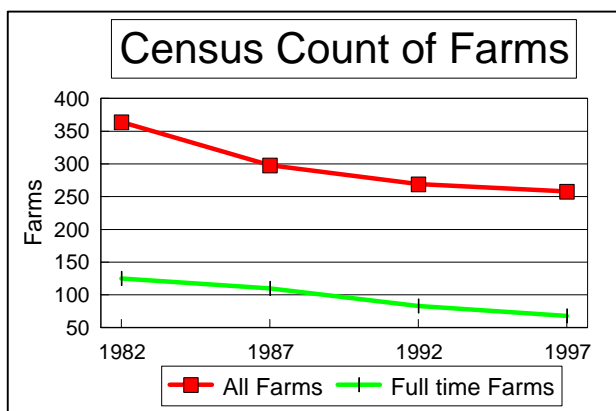
Increased 44 percent to \$2,778,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 32 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 68 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 50 percent from \$7,160 in 1992 to \$10,766 in 1997.
