Decreased 8 percent from 339 acres in 1992 to 311 acres in 1997.

Decreased 5 percent from 393 farms in 1992 to 373 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

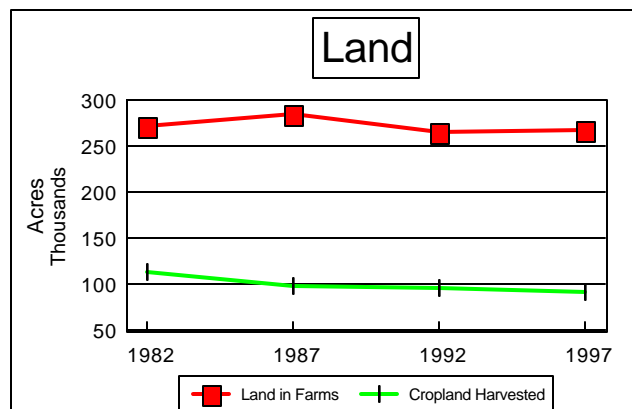
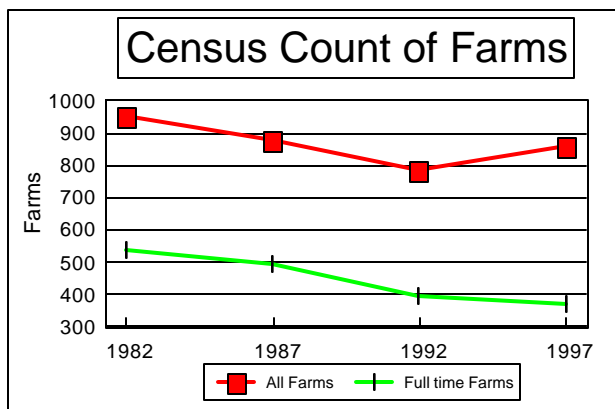
Increased 3 percent to \$21,804,000 in 1997.
