Average size of farms

Increased slightly from 265 acres in 1992 to 266 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 9 percent from 258 farms in 1992 to 234 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

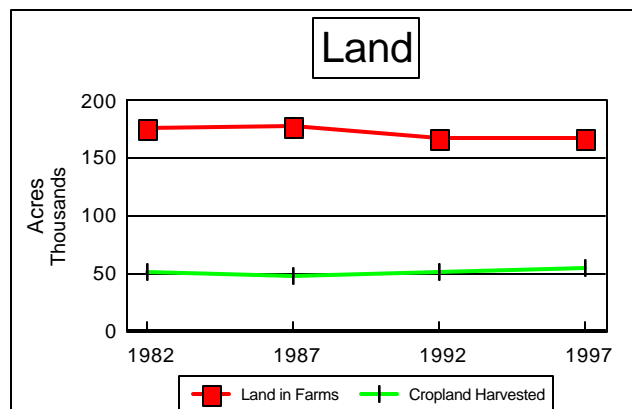
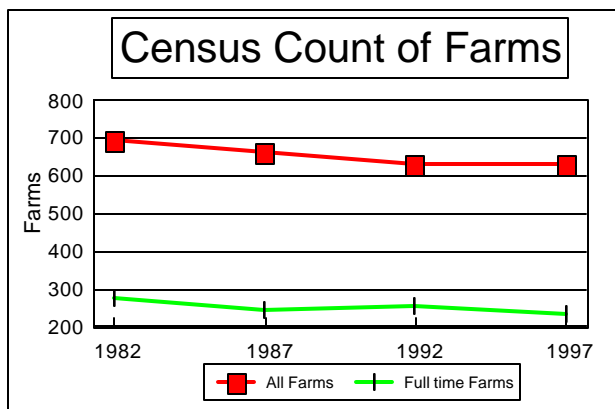
Decreased 2 percent to \$17,905,000 in 1997.
