Increased 6 percent from 326 acres in 1992 to 345 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 16 percent from 219 farms in 1992 to 185 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

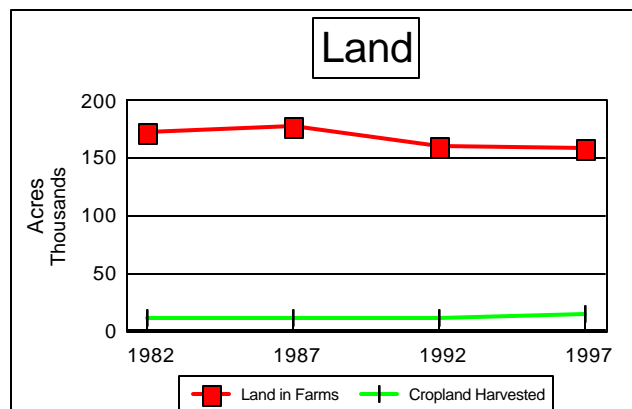
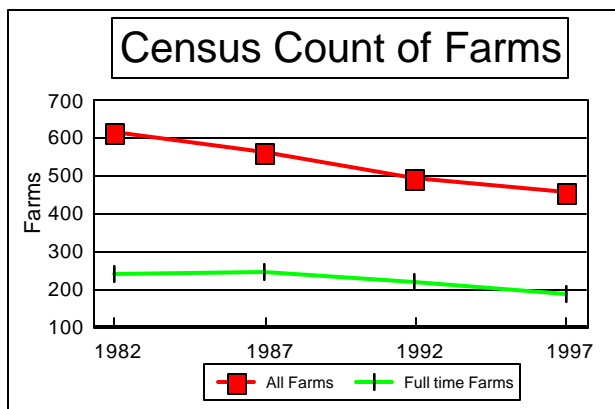
Increased 33 percent to \$9,937,000 in 1997.
