Market value of agricultural products sold

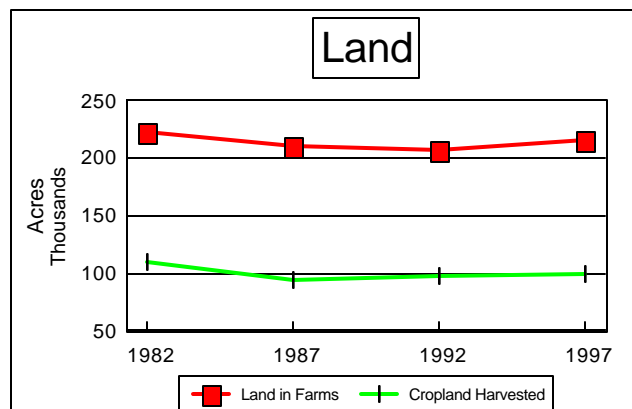
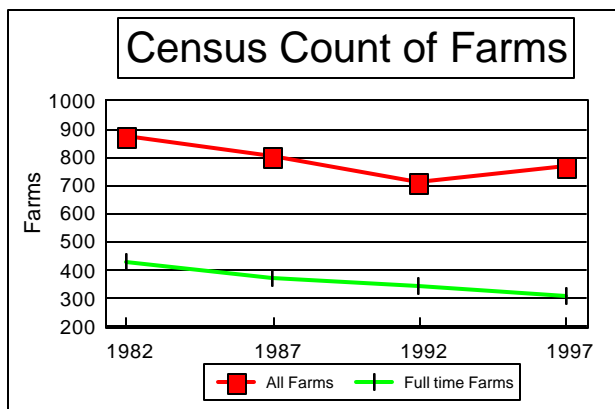
Increased 3 percent to \$34,565,000 in 1997.
