Decreased 3 percent from 285,496 acres in 1992 to 277,043 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 2 percent from 136 acres in 1992 to 139 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 8 percent from 797 farms in 1992 to 735 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

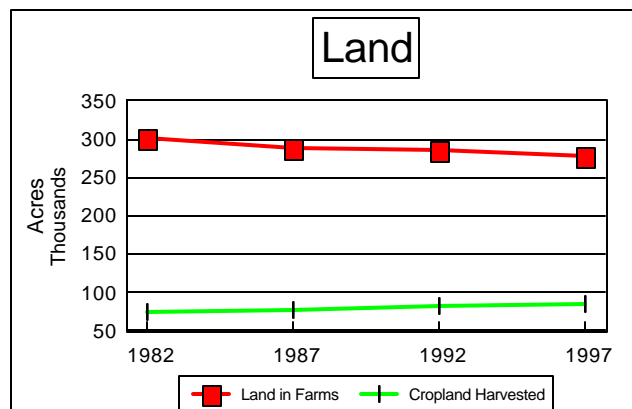
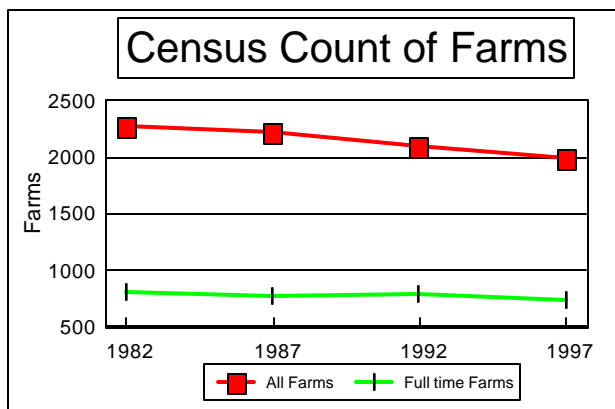
Decreased 20 percent to \$33,414,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 84 percent of the market value.
