Decreased 15 percent from 509 farms in 1992 to 435 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

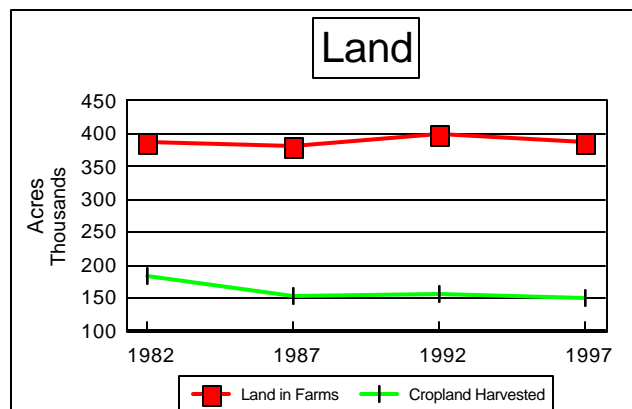
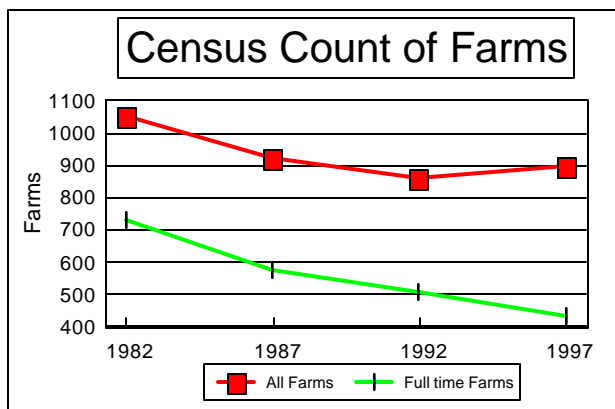
Increased 18 percent to \$44,394,000 in 1997.
