Increased 11 percent from 177 acres in 1992 to 197 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 302 farms in 1992 to 281 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

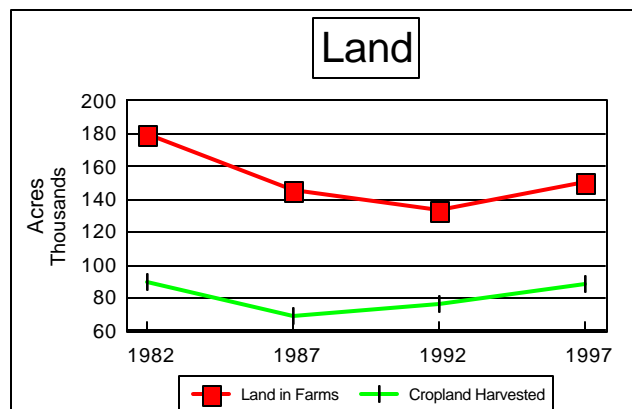
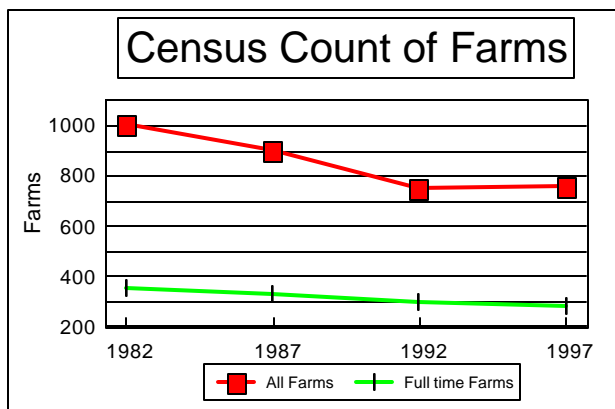
Increased 6 percent to \$27,586,000 in 1997.
