Average size of farms

Increased 1 percent from 243 acres in 1992 to 246 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 9 percent from 754 farms in 1992 to 683 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

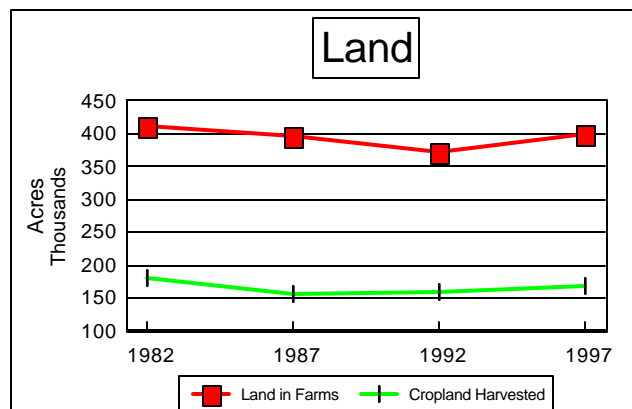
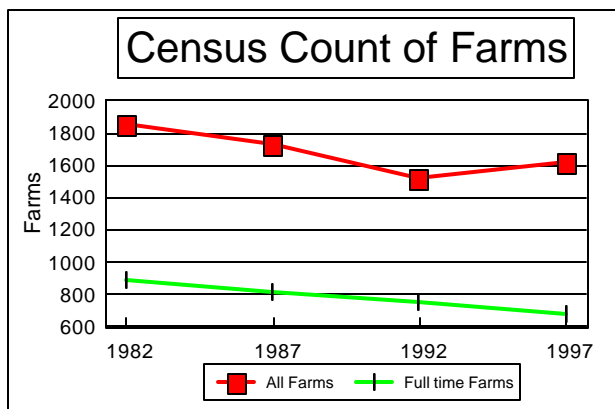
Decreased 7 percent to \$53,791,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 62 percent of the market value.
