Decreased 17 percent from 418 farms in 1992 to 349 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

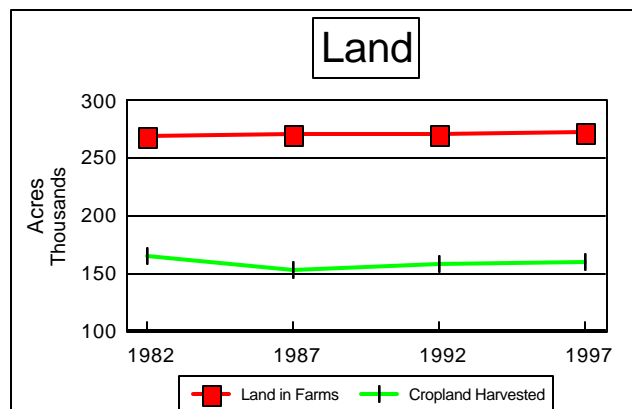
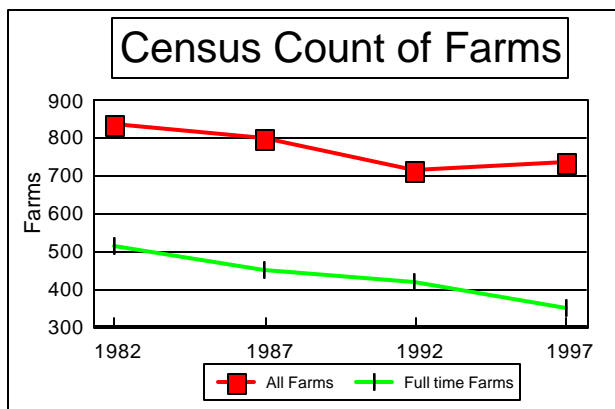
Increased 14 percent to \$37,179,000 in 1997.

Livestock sales accounted for 21 percent of the market value.
