Decreased slightly from 220 acres in 1992 to 218 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 445 farms in 1992 to 415 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

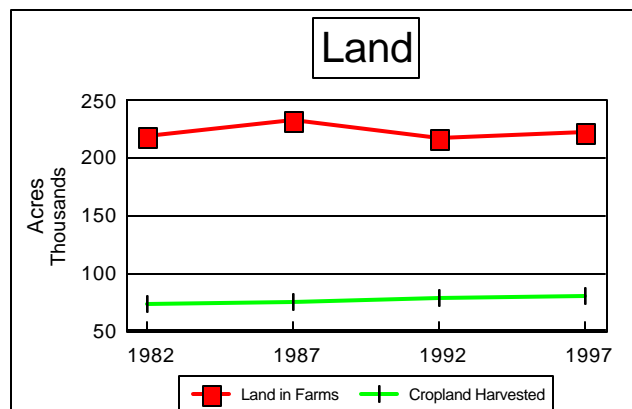
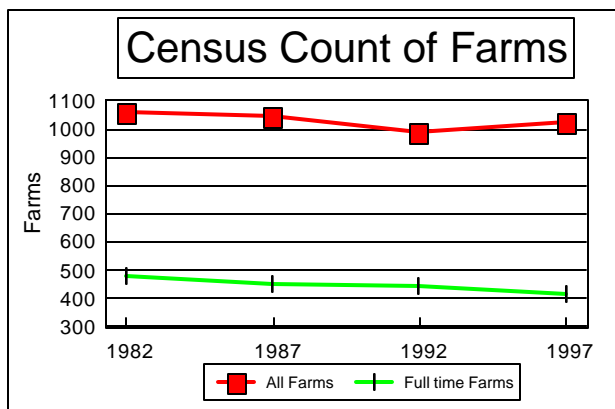
Increased 40 percent to \$52,868,000 in 1997.
