Decreased 4 percent from 428 farms in 1992 to 412 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

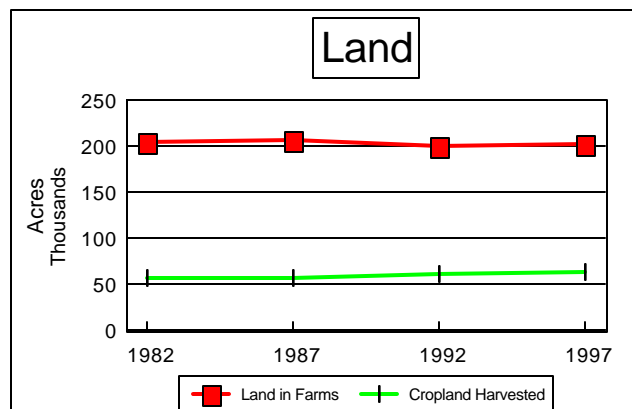
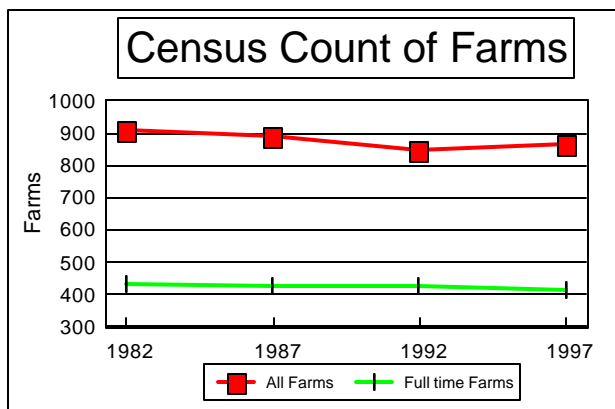
Increased 97 percent to \$91,101,000 in 1997.
