Land in farms

Increased 26 percent from 89,683 acres in 1992 to 113,214 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 25 percent from 301 acres in 1992 to 375 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 4 percent from 107 farms in 1992 to 103 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

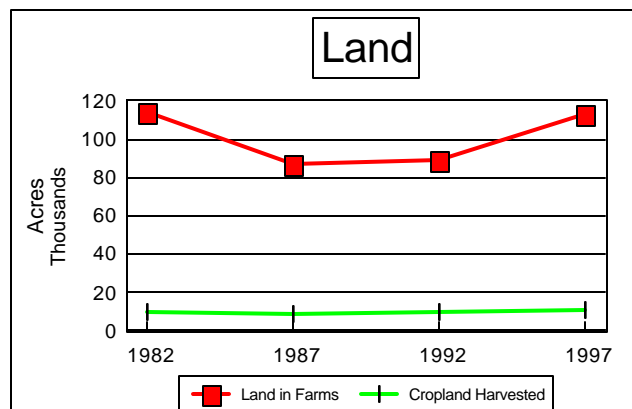
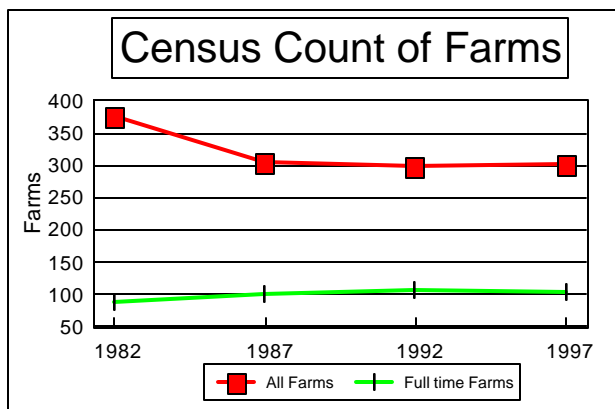
Decreased 11 percent to \$3,105,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 9 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 91 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 12 percent from \$11,652 in 1992 to \$10,282 in 1997.
