Land in farms

Increased 1 percent from 1,414,415 acres in 1992 to 1,430,064 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 13 percent from 2,694 acres in 1992 to 2,348 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 4 percent from 401 farms in 1992 to 416 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

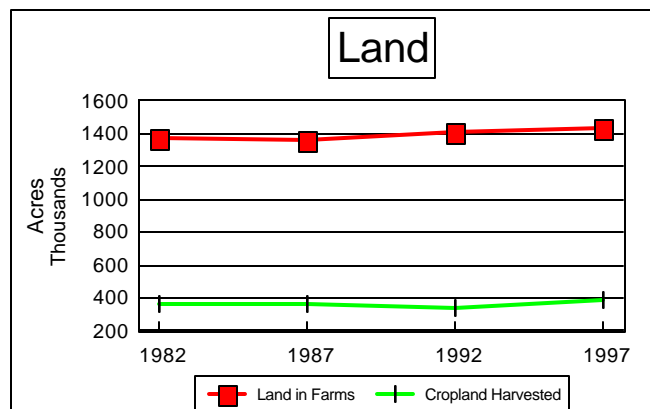
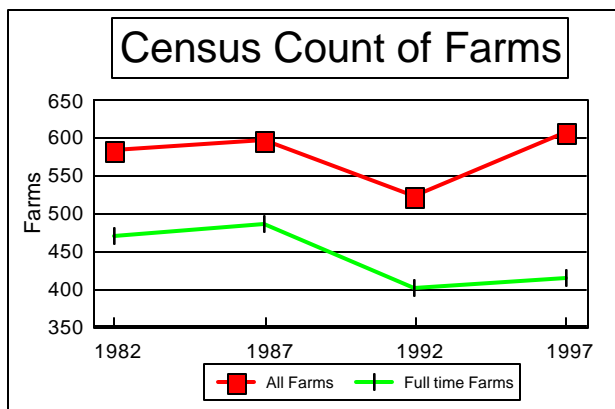
Increased 5 percent to \$38,812,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 77 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 23 percent of the market value.
