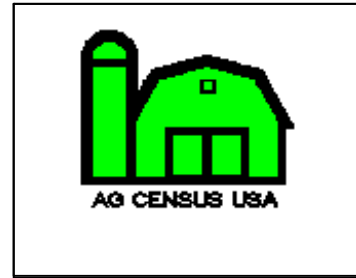

Land in farms

Increased 3 percent from 335,465 acres in 1992 to 344,322 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 8 percent from 511 acres in 1992 to 553 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 500 farms in 1992 to 464 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

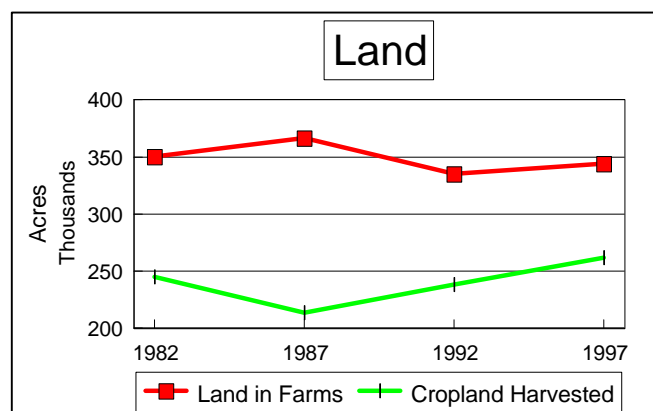
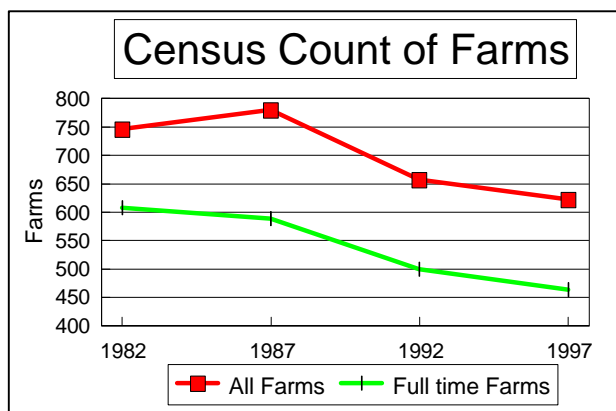
Increased 4 percent to \$159,384,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 49 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 51 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm
