Decreased 5 percent from 458 farms in 1992 to 435 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

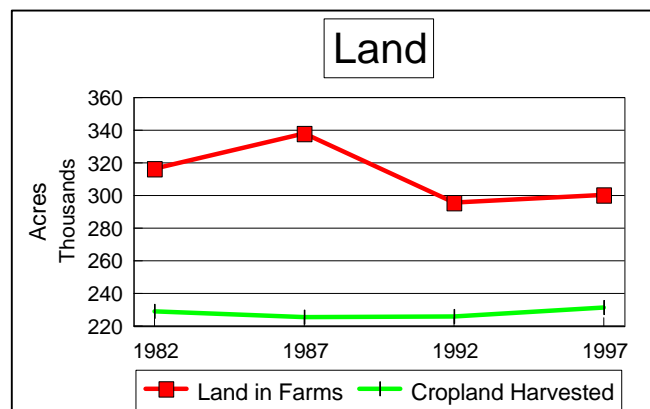
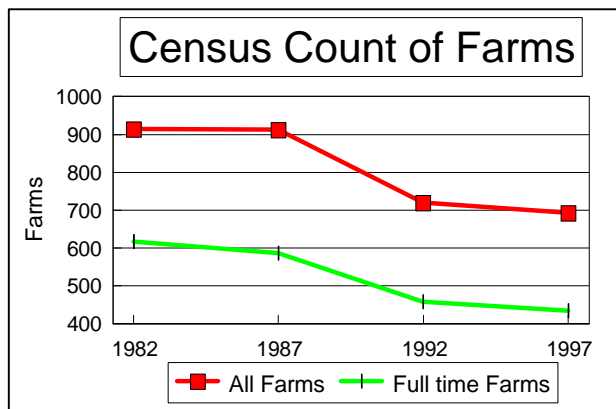
Increased 5 percent to \$67,160,000 in 1997.
