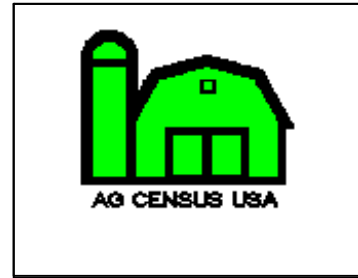


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## DUNDY NEBRASKA

### Land in farms

Increased 12 percent from 528,731 acres in 1992 to 590,935 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased 7 percent from 1,717 acres in 1992 to 1,830 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Increased 2 percent from 245 farms in 1992 to 249 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

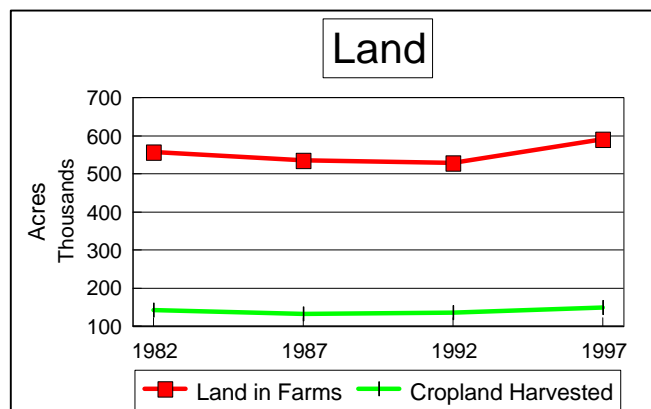
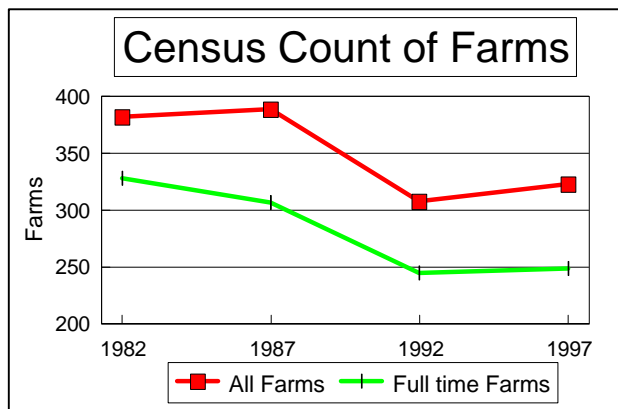
Increased 7 percent to \$86,632,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 46 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 54 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 2 percent from \$264,002 in 1992 to \$268,209 in 1997.
