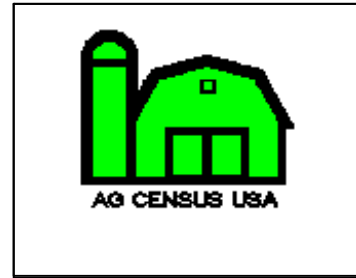


# 1997 Census of Agriculture County Profile

## KIMBALL NEBRASKA

### Land in farms

Increased 12 percent from 505,150 acres in 1992 to 565,199 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Increased slightly from 1,730 acres in 1992 to 1,734 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Unchanged from 209 farms in 1992 to 209 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

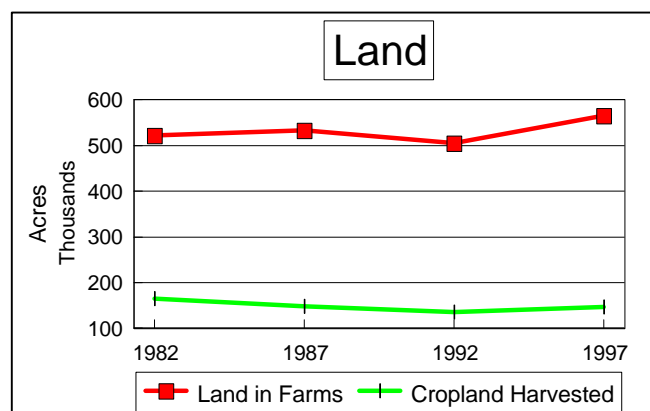
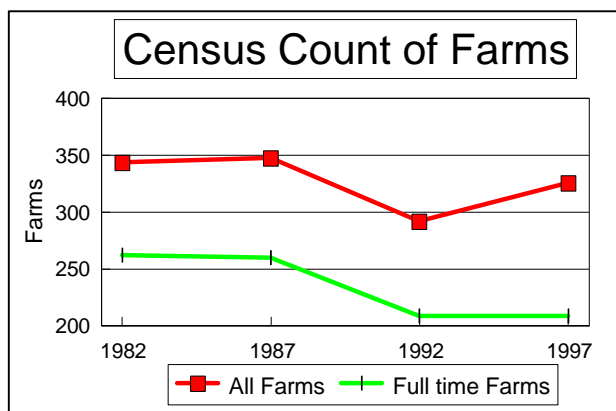
Increased 12 percent to \$22,884,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 61 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 39 percent of the market value.
