Increased 3 percent from 2,525 acres in 1992 to 2,605 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 4 percent from 111 farms in 1992 to 107 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

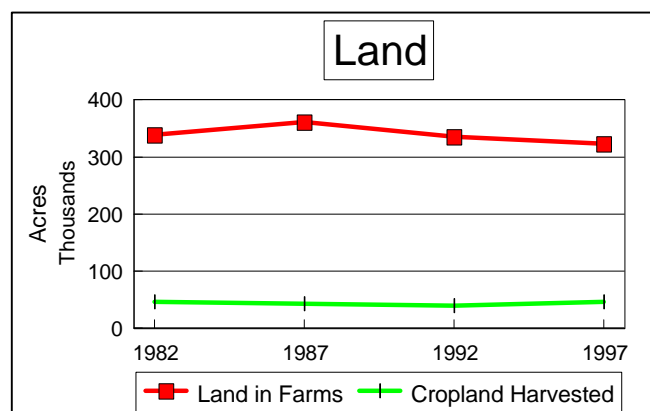
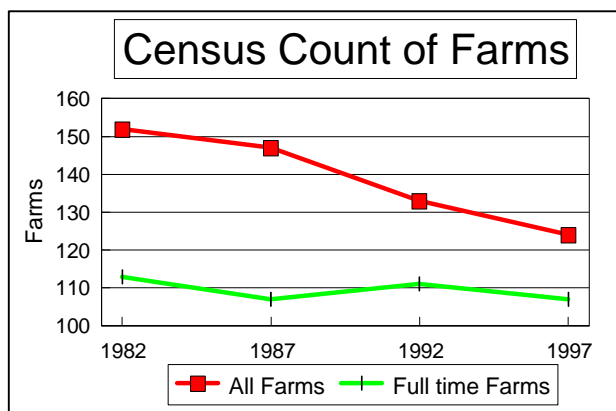
Increased 16 percent to \$19,107,000 in 1997.
