Decreased 9 percent from 614 farms in 1992 to 559 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

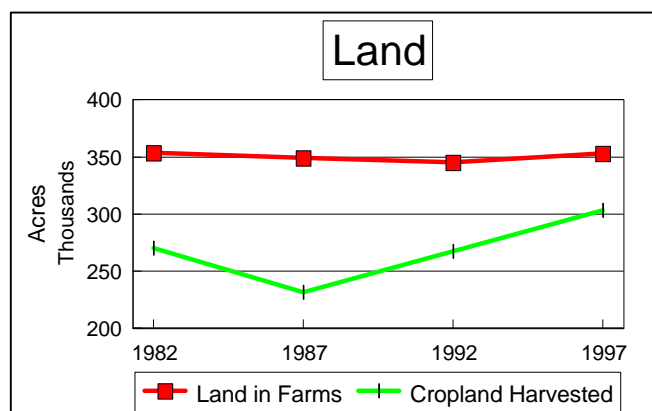
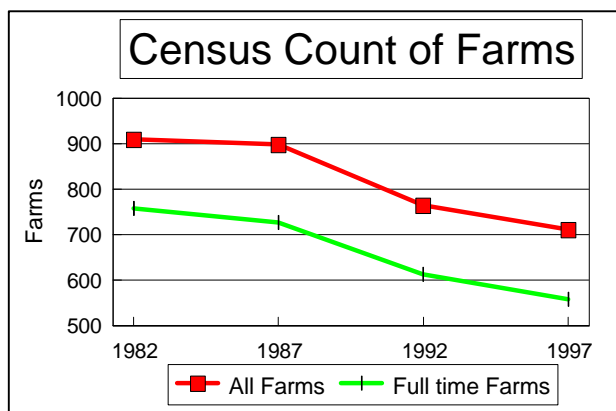
Increased 18 percent to \$178,311,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 56 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 44 percent of the market value.

Increased 27 percent from \$197,911 in 1992 to \$250,437 in 1997.
