Market value of agricultural products sold

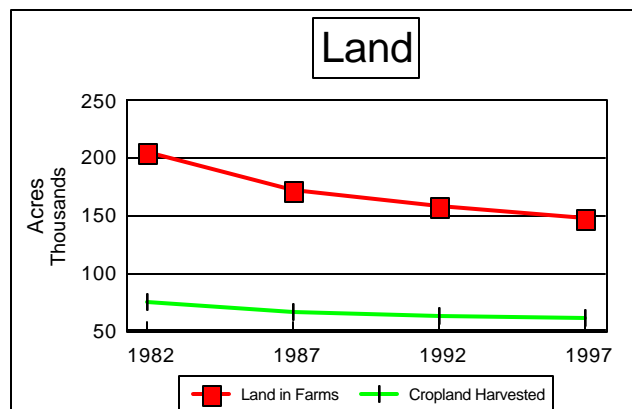
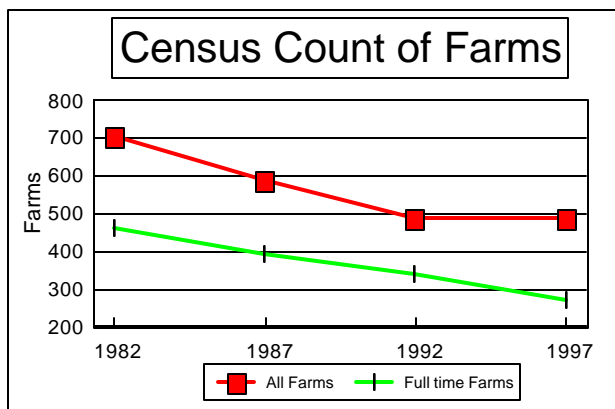
Increased 22 percent to \$69,328,000 in 1997.
