Market value of agricultural products sold

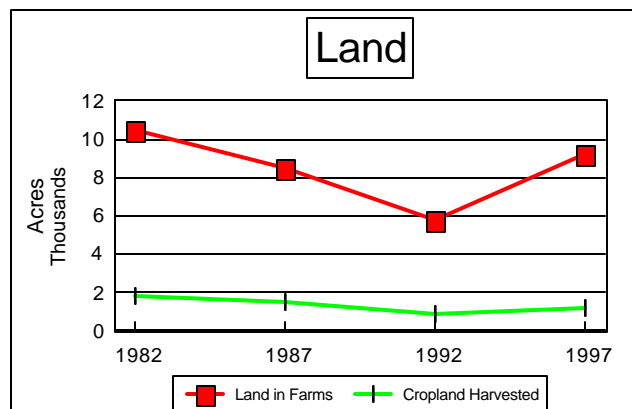
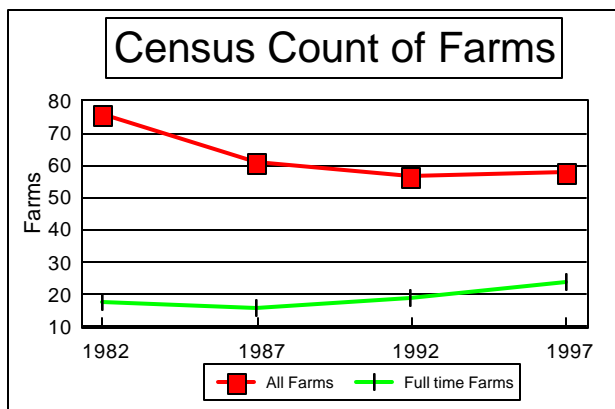
Increased 43 percent to \$2,180,000 in 1997.
