Market value of agricultural products sold

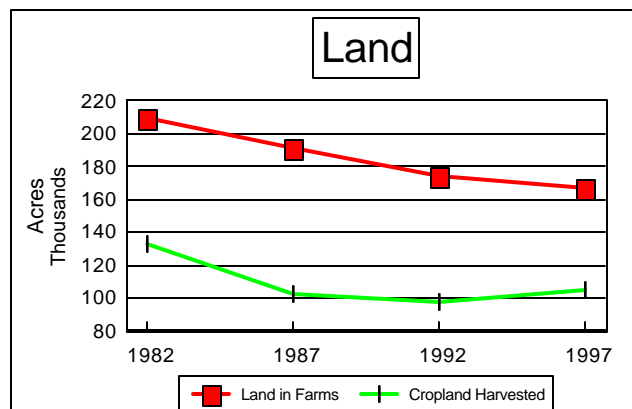
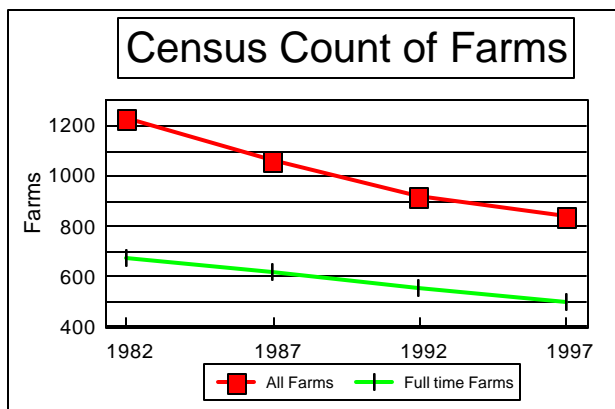
Increased 19 percent to \$107,566,000 in 1997.
