

Increased slightly from 1,285 acres in 1992 to 1,292 acres in 1997.

Decreased 11 percent from 810 farms in 1992 to 724 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Decreased 7 percent to \$92,543,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 73 percent of the market value.
