Increased 6 percent from 1,211 acres in 1992 to 1,285 acres in 1997.

Decreased 5 percent from 366 farms in 1992 to 347 farms in 1997.


Market value of agricultural products sold

Increased 21 percent to \$28,788,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 87 percent of the market value. Livestock sales accounted for 13 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 17 percent from \$51,349 in 1992 to \$60,100 in 1997.
