

Increased 16 percent from 31 acres in 1992 to 36 acres in 1997.

Decreased 9 percent from 69 farms in 1992 to 63 farms in 1997.


Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 8 percent to \$17,147,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 97 percent of the market value. Livestock sales accounted for 3 percent of the market value.
