

# JEFFERSON OHIO

Land in farms

Increased 4 percent from 68,344 acres in 1992 to 71,304 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 4 percent from 181 acres in 1992 to 174 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 2 percent from 156 farms in 1992 to 159 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold


Increased 4 percent to \$6,703,000 in 1997.


Crop sales accounted for 29 percent of the market value.
