## LOGAN OHIO

### Land in farms

Increased 8 percent from 202,927 acres in 1992 to 218,957 acres in 1997.

### Average size of farms

Decreased 2 percent from 251 acres in 1992 to 245 acres in 1997.

### Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 380 farms in 1992 to 353 farms in 1997.

### Market value of agricultural products sold

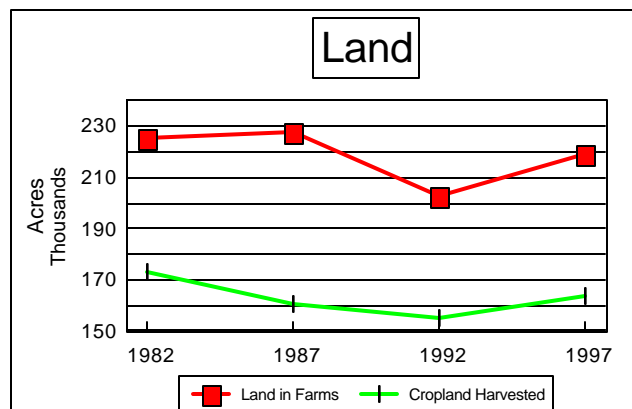
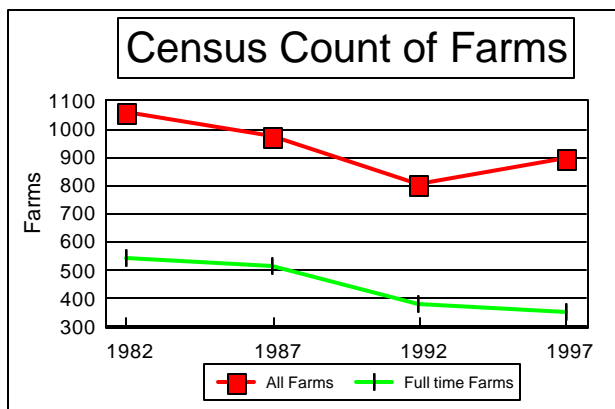
Increased 59 percent to \$89,077,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 46 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 54 percent of the market value.

### Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 44 percent from \$69,234 in 1992 to \$99,528 in 1997.
