Market value of agricultural products sold

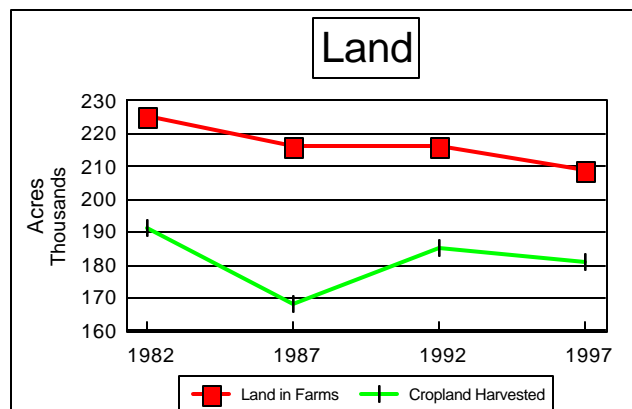
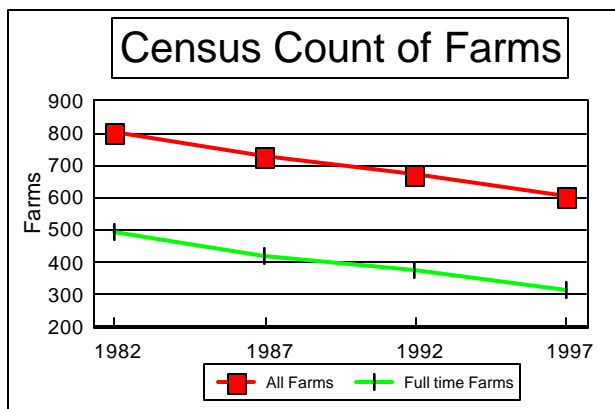
Increased 28 percent to \$63,690,000 in 1997.
